Fish for a Cure Makes Waves in Cancer Care for Our Community

ORGANIZATION OVERVIEW:

Fish For A Cure (F4AC) is a fishing tournament and fundraising challenge that raises funds for cancer care at Luminis Health Anne Arundel Medical Center (LHAAMC). The F4AC tournament, Paul C. Dettor Captain's Challenge, and Shore Party will be held on Saturday, Nov. 1, 2025, in Annapolis, Md.

WHERE THE FUNDS GO:

All funds raised through F4AC directly benefit the Cancer Survivorship Program at LHAAMC's Geaton and JoAnn DeCesaris Cancer Institute. This program offers support for patients and their families by providing services such as nurse navigation, education, genetics counseling, support groups, social work, and psychosocial services.

FACTS:

- In 2024:
 - 58 boats registered, all of which competed in the Paul C. Dettor Captain's Challenge, a competitive fundraising challenge.
 - There were 58 captains and 123 anglers.
 - The partnership of more than 84 sponsors and community partners helped make the event possible.
 - Reel Counsel raised \$228,615.23, winning the Legends League and breaking a fundraising record. All Tackle raised \$49,274, winning the Open League.
 - Over 2,700 donations were made ranging from \$1 to \$25,000 to support the Cancer Survivorship Program at LHAAMC Geaton and JoAnn DeCesaris Cancer Institute.
- F4AC has raised more than \$6.5 million over the last 18 years.
- Funds raised through F4AC each year support more than 2,000 people experiencing the unique challenges of a cancer diagnosis with access to critically needed psychosocial services, including nurse navigation, nutrition counseling, psychosocial well-being, and oncology rehabilitation services.
